TUESDAY 19

1876

This should be entered on Friday 22nd

Take Care for Buffalo. Take up
Steam Gauge & get fixed. I buy
Car Soft Nut Coal, at \$2.40, order
Wrapping Paper, & get Gas fixing
at Toups. Take up 13 Bbls Flouring
for S. H. Wash Jr. he pays me \$125 for
Bbl & freight of Bbls done \$1.00.

Mr. Laursen Jr goes up. Gladwin
meets me at Station on returning & tells
me Hughes was very drunk all day. I
give him instructions & charge of Taming
& orders for watchman. & Forbid Jimmy
Doyle to give Hughes any liquor.

This AM, Uncle John & I take Care for
Ho to attend Merchants trials with
Pink, Grace Dickson. Wife dies
at St. C today. Meet Wm. Thompson
on bus & family, going up to derive
from bridge, Expenses \$5.00.

DECEMBER

WEDNESDAY 20

1876

Go to Taming at 7. Give Hughes blowing
up & discharge him. Follett comes
down Huddle & Hughes & gets me
to take him back. He promises
to go up & be reinstated at Lodge
tonight. I forbid J. Rosseau to give
Hughes any more liquor. I catch
Willie Rosseau quivering him whiskey
not 5 minutes after. Hughes goes
up to Lodge & is reinstated. Herbert
joins tonight. I go with him.
