Brought home Timothy seed as before mentioned and two bushels of potatoes for which Turner is either to have the same measure in return or 2 shillings per bushel. Robert after sap brought Father and Fred chopping over on J. Goble's lot. I did and me measuring, lined and measured up the chopping. I did for him. Hatching 2 acres 57 rods. Chopping 1a. 1rod. 20 chains. underbushing 1a. 3r. 1rod.

Tuesday 3rd.

Cold, sunshiny. Father and Phil went to saw mill came back empty. Fred chopping and Father and Phil in the afternoon. Robert after pails and buckets washing, spouts, coopering, made a handle.

Wednesday 4th.

Morning fresh, mild and thawing during the day. Father, Robert, Fred and chopping over on John's. Fixed an axe handle carried buckets to trees tapping trees in the afternoon. Baled wood with John Goble the result will appear in a day or two. 3-3-0 2 1/2 p.m.

Thursday 5th.

Fine mild and pleasant. Robert & Phil went to
