

April 18 We finished the roof this forenoon Ad went away on the express he will meet the rest in Toronto & go to

Fort Garry fine day

19 went to a revision of Mr Cross in the forenoon laid up part of the road fence they are terribly blown

20 finished sowing grass seed in field South of the main ditch it was sowed last spring but it has not caught finished fixing the outside fence very dry with

21 no meeting to day fine warm day

22 fixed some irons for the truck wagon & went to the station to Christopher Young & his family go away on the Express he sold his farm here & is going to the village of Hariston in the County of Wellington

23 very hard frost last night drew dung to the garden & ashes & chips to the orchard Snow

24 mended Berner boots & took the old leather of the old bellows

25 sawed 4 sheepskins together for a cover for the bellows & helped John McKee to take down the scaffolding in the church he finished the plastering to day all but the pulpit on the

26 spread dung in the middle field the dung was taken out last fall the bottom of the heaps is now frozen

X 27 went to Gananoque with 7 bushel of barley for cows silled with ^{Wm Broughy} was endeared him \$19.75 and paid him & bought 36 lb of grass seed \$2.44 18 ped of silk thread 75 1 box of soap 9 cotton yarn 95

28 The Rev. Mr Robinson preached in the schoolhouse in the evening

29 began to plow & plowed 2 short ridges in the garden then plowed in the middle field for peas the frost is not out of the dung heap yet

30 finished plowing that piece all but the head & sowed it in peas fine warm day

X silled with J. F. Bradley & paid \$11.35 and was endeared him
