Gynecological Hint.

Cardiac murmurs, unless accompanied by dilatation of the heart, are not a contraindication to anesthesia with ether for the performance of gynecological operations. In fact, most large uterine fibroids are associated with heart murmurs which usually disappear after removal of the growths. These murmurs are rarely present when the tumors are small; but develop late and seem in certain instances to coexist with more or less degeneration of the fibroids.—Waldo; Int. Journ. of Surg.
