Cloudy and sunny looked like rain at times warm. We plowed and harrowed in green crop land to-day, No 5 not dry enough yet to work. I had lumber today. I planted 5 turnips in wheat to night

Cloudy and sunny AM rained at intervals PM. We finished cultivating No 2 and cultivated and disked some No 5 AM. PM took stuff and took over in wagon after barn and worked at getting roller mended. May down town PM got her dress from Mrs Barly \$3.00 for soap Phillips 25 - paid Thompson for mattress \$5.00 for mother. I drove down at night Jess in buggy for papers also to Mrs. McKees for 2 settings (26) of White Leghorn eggs 50 Ts. sold dry egg 17 paid for comb Esip 17 ds cake for boy Mrs Mitchell ne James Harlin buried to-day.
