Every woman should know that 75 per cent. of the tumors of the breast are or will become malignant. Any tumor in the breast of a woman over twenty-five should be explored. If the tumor proves benign, no mutilating operation need be performed.

In the breasts of girls at or about puberty nodules may appear, or one breast may develop faster than the other. There is no indication to operate on these unless the nodules should become persistent in their growth.—McGregor; *Northwestern Lancet.*
