Duty to Reduce Damages by Submitting to Operation.

When one who has been injured, but is advised by competent physicians that the injury can be remedied by an operation that is ordinarily not dangerous, but refuses to submit to the operation, he is not minimizing his damages, and cannot recover for the sufferings which would be avoided by the needed operation. It is incumbent upon the injured person to submit to reasonable treatment, and to follow the advice of competent physicians.—*Donovan v. New Orleans Ry. & Light Co.*, Louisiana Supreme Court, 61 So. 216.
