

- April 25 (Sunday) Raw. and raining. John to Gt. Goswain
 26. Milder. Discing in 11. John to Gt. Goswain Kelly Picking Potatoes
- May 15
- 27 Sowing mixed grain in 6. Cold Rain all afternoon
- 28 Very hard frost. No getting on the land in forenoon. Draining and ^{cleaning} bedding wood
- 29 Hard frost - a gain. A snow storm from the East all day. ^{with} 2 feet deep and high wind. Thunder storm in Evening and most of the night with rain freezing soil - fell. Sleighs running to the S. W. of us. Snow ploughs out on R. Ry. at Stratford. fast lambs
- 30 Milder and misty all day. but snow not there. gone
- May 1 Cold raw day. Showers of snow all day usual - night. Ground covered 2 in deep. The latest coldest spring since 1883 when we record first on 3rd May. Picking Potatoes. A and goats to Fagus. John taking down fence
- 2 (Sunday) Weather worse and colder. fierce showers of snow all day 2 in deep again at night. John to May to Gt. at night
- 3 Heavy fall of snow this morning between 2 & 3 in cleared off and all melted. Fanning up oats. drawing up hay. hanging Gate &c.
- 4 Warmer. but snow flying. To Fagus. Re. Dutchman. Discing in 11
- 5 First real spring day. Swallows here. Finished Discing in 11 sowing in 12. Harrowing in 11. Land dried a lot. A. at Remies
- 6 Fine and warm. finished sowing in 12. Harrowing in 11. started to snow in 15 in afternoon snowbank in corner of it. Thunderstorm and Rain at night. A. at Remies
- 7 Wet Cold morning. clearing up in afternoon. Cultivating and sowing in 15. Finished Harrowing in 12. To Orangeville with gr. White
- 8 Fine. Finished sowing and harrowing 15
- 9 (Sunday) Wet forenoon warm. Thunder and Rain afternoon and again at night: gr. & Manx's Gt.
- 10 Cold Rain from the north all day. Land very wet again
- 11 Frost. Dry Clear day. Sowing stakes for Fence in forenoon. Sowing Pass. and Oats and Harrowing in 11. Last Lamb Game. 1 Box. 1 Box. 3. 7th Pair of Swals & Son
- 12 Fine. warm. Finished sowing & harrowing 11. discing 3. Picking stores in 15
- 13 Finished Picking stores in 15. sowed 3. Cultivated 5. Harrowing in 3. Lots of. Lightning on the Lake. Evening. Ran. Northern lights ^{change} ^{thunder}
- 14 Very warm. sowed 5. Finished Harrowing 3. Rain after dinner ^{near} ^{down} ^{the} ^{hill}
- 15 Damp morning. on Cultivating in 7 finished harrowing in 5. Thunderstorm
