 a heifer Mr Kelly at Fisherman's Bohemian
 Late coming up with the fog have 2 in 40
 to Narcise to fetch up 4 Bags of Potatoes
 13th Foggy Bohemian late going down
 & Wind changed to West Ploughed the Potatoes
 Rice all Firing Fence went to head of Island
 let out the 2 Bulls for to Day 14th Planted
 4 Rows of Potatoes Ploughed the Bean place Firing
 the Fence Granada went to Lancaster high & Wind
 changed Rain to night Young Chickens 12 Yr running
 the apple tree at the Door and one at Langfence
 Hernandez caught Perch Randolph caught
 Quill Water high 15th Raining high south
 West Wind Fisherman took 4 Bags of Potatoes
 from Montreal 4.5 a Bag good many Rats
 their going to take them back cut some pieces
 of Building high Wind to night Tolemays fish
 came back from Montreal could not sell them
 fixing Fresh Fence Water high in the evening
 16th Fish here from Murrisk 16 2 orals 17th
 17th 18th and 19th to be doing the Island 18th Planted
 few Rows planted potatoes in the Bean place 15th
 heared the 2 Rams planted 8 or 9 Rows to the apple
 of a Channel Catfish from the Fishermen 20th Began
 the East end of the House Narcise Randolph
 plowing scoring sand the Foundation
 Keeping on the Bulls at night
