We drove to Jim Hunt for dinner then called on Siggie Worr came down called on Peter Shank and wife then down to Cameron's again got tea changed rigs got home after nine o'clock. Willie plowed No 6 in P.M. Mary gave to children M. front 10¢
Suzanna 15¢.

Friday

Sunny day very windy all day. Willie plowed in No 6 AM and I cut wood in bush and brought up load. In P.M. Willie and I went to Show.

October 1

Saturday

Fine sunny day exceedingly windy. Willie took 6 bags chop to Carle's 30¢ per and brought up load manure from Steet's put it on 7 L then brought over load wood. In P.M. he plowed in No 6. Bella and I went down to church. Mr. McVie preached coll 5¢, I paid C. Groves a/c \$3.20 binder time 1.00 skinned 1.00 rubbers 20 wash machine 10 sold him oats 2.20 sold 7 red barley oats \$3.95 Willie got gloves at Nichols 25¢ refund on shoes 20¢ per 5¢
Black pig had 10 of a litter to-day one killed smothered.
