Rained heavy last night and more or less all a.m. Thunder & lightning most all day cleared by night. We did inside work a.m. I cleaned cellar mixed up odds & ends of paint. P.M. I went to Elora Mand & Punch in waggons returned lime bags to lime kiln gave order to H. Richardson for lumber for 4 gates gave cheque \$7.42 got at Wilsons oranges 40 cts brought load lime home with me from Kiln got for taking also got some lump lime 10 cts took cream to Russells. Willie chopped. I brought calf feed for Farnest. got at Richardson. I went up to Armstrongs at night.
