on the roses & beds in front of the house and this afternoon helped Frank shingle the cow stable roof which Dad plowed. Lovely day, mild.

Sunday December 3rd

Frank and I went down to Sunday school & church. Even Dad & the baby stayed down at Auntie's to dinner. I drove down after dinner and Dad took Auntie Alice up to the cemetery. I sat around the bank all the afternoon & went down to Auntie's for tea. Auntie Alice & I went to church to night.

Monday December 4th

Dad & Frank plowed all day between them. Frank and I cleaned some more ditches and shingled some more of the cow stable roof. ^{certificates at afternoon.} It was a cloudy, drizzly day. Got word today that they want the Beattie roses.

Tuesday December 5th

I rode up to Dunkin's today to get the American certificate for the Beattie rose. Got up there about noon. Stopped at Top's. Helen invited me to dinner so stayed. Got home about five o'clock. Went down to night to a practice for the Christmas cantata for the Sunday school kids. Cloudy & windy but not very cold.
