- 28 (Sunday) Calm. Clear. Cold. To be in morning. for Stan and Mary in evening. Sleighing very poor. Barkham evening
- March 1 Cloudy. Cold. Rain some snow flying. Turnip to Scheris. Mrs. Wright & family (two in evening)
- 2 Very fine frosty. To Fagan with sheep. for Stan & S. Signs of storm
- 3 Very stormy. Snowing and drifting from N.E.
- 4 Another stormy day and cold. A and S up to Mrs. Fagan's. De Fagan's christened. All of us up at D. Deane's at a party.
- 5 Day. Cold. Took Mary to Fagan to see Russell's. Load of Turnip to Scheris
- 6 Fine. Mild. to day. Load of Turnip to A. to the in afternoon
- 7 (Sunday) Fine (mild to the morning) (Communion) John & Stan at night. (A. Deane)
- 8 Mild and sunny. To Belwood to Council meeting. Re. School. S. & Balgarnet
