15 F & A ganged at other place

A.M. A horse we had at home in oat
field that was ganged I ganged

at other place P.M. H went driving
engine for W Resor J & Henry

Made 55 gals Cider P.M.
W. fine clear A B. Jesse & Martha

brought 2 Leopard girls from
Clinton or Belkham to drive W. fine

16 I worked at B. C. in B's place he is
not very well H plowed A.M. I went
