Sat May 7th clear fore part of the day and hot after noon clear cloudy. I finished planting potatoes, after was makeing grafting wase and doing some grafting

Sun May 8th cloudy a little sprinkl of rain

Mon May 9th cloudy and cool. I planted my corn. Sarah was ~~here~~ here papering the house

Tue May 10th cloudy and cool. I grafted a few apple ~~to~~ limbs and cut the limbs in stove wood. Sarah was papering

Wed May 11th cloudy and cool. Sarah finished papering the house. Mary calld in a few minutes this after noon.

Thu May 12th cloudy and hot. this being my birth day Mary, Sarah, and werrt Tom Boltons and had our dinners. coming home I saw bobalinks the first for this Season

Fri May 13th cloudy a soft day sprinkling rain part of the time Sarah here cleaning the house I hoed the garden
