fine rain this morning went to the Church but Mr Carroll did not come

21

Ad finished the fallow worked at the cellar rain this afternoon

The Revd Mr Given preached in our ^{large} church

rain 28

went to Marble Rock for clapboards they was not ready stoff till they sawed them ^{rain} got 100' but paid 10 per 1000 yards then a deer bill ^{cut} Ad got from T. Seath for \$9.75 the rest.

rain 29

the boys finished the potatoes

30

went to Gananoque for lime had to give 8 per

31

Do Do for another load of berries that 50 bushel I got 300 of indian meal 6.00 per 100
