we didn't get much done the short  
carriers also broke all up and we had to  
fix them after dinner. Mary down town  
P.M. got meat at Shorttuck \$1.00 (they also  
brought up meat this morning \$1.40 on ap-  
provision at Russell's 75¢ D. Fursy in full \$3.00.
