had a Treat on Credit got an order from
Mr Crippin to let a Barrel at J M Kays
But there was none got a Ride across
from Hugh Grant and Mr J Craig stop
at Summers had a Treat not Craig
met Mr Hopkins on the Road helped
us with the Logs as we were near upsetting
Heard Mr Kimball departed a very fine
man when out on the Lake a Yennet
got a Budget from Charlie Mr John Craig drawing
his grain from Jacobs Island
