- Mon Sept 24. Fine day, bright and sunny. Cleaned Parlor and Dining Room had Mrs D. Electric cleaner, picked a few apples. quite a frost.
- Tue Sept 25. Fair but dull and rather cold. Cleaned kitchen and cleaned store. all finished house cleaning. W. Martin finished picking apples. 50 cents but gave him 75 cents, 5.-
- Wed Sept 26. Fair but dull and cool until a light shower in eve. I took flowers up but did not remain to decorate. Annie here at night
- Thur Sept 27. Dull and rather cold, with a few squalls. Mrs D, Annie and I at Thanksgiving Service. not many out 30. I was at Annies Mr Robins of Markham preached.
- Fri Sept 28. Fine and brighter, I finished up shed. Mrs Hunt got a bus of apples \$1.00, 5.
