- February 16 Friday toward 40483 19965  
 Cloudy in morning turned out fine sunny  
 Frosty day. I went over to Wilsons with  
 Anna in am In PM Willie took  
 box of butter down expressed by C P & H  
 to P&H Blk Co then we went to Dehain's  
 sole after which we brought up load wood  
 from brush in sleigh.
- 17 Saturday  
 Fine sunny day, thawing in sun. We cut  
 the load wood brought yesterday. In PM we hauled  
 back 3 loads manure from box stall and brought  
 up load wood from brush. Father up in PM. He  
 Willie and Mary drove down at night. May stayed down  
 Willie got at Morris' house shoe nails 10cts
- 18 Sunday  
 Fine day mild snowed some at night.  
 Mr Thornton a student Black hair preached  
 in AM from Duet 30:19 and in evening  
 from Rev 3:20. Church toll .50cts
- 19 Monday  
 Mild day Thawing some cloudy. We  
 cut load wood am I took load straw down to  
 Smith in PM. Jno McKee got \$2.70 for  
 oats in PM at 35¢ a bushel Jno Black  
 brought hind quarter of cow he killed which we  
 brought off him
- 20 Tuesday  
 Mild cloudy, thawing, raining some  
 in PM. Willie went down town  
 with wagon in AM got scatshed
