1. Saturday. It began to rain this morning and kept up a gentle drizzle all day. It will put out the bush fires. The great Lacrosse match of the season was taken place today in Cornwall, St. John's up to see it. Cornwall won 3 straight. I washed & baked today. Bird mopped. John Saddle died this evening 7 P.M.
2. Rev. A. McGilvray preached here today. Left John 4 chaff 13, 14 buses. It has been showery all afternoon.
3. John Saddle buried at St. Raphael, Pa. Far & Jimmie were at the Mass. It began to rain about 1 P.M. and was showery all afternoon. I sent the books to the Institute.
4. Womens meeting today James Dwyer's R.R. Mrs. McGilvray of Brockville would like to be at our meeting, and could not wait until Thursday so it was held today. Had a letter Maudy.
5. Rained a little today was at prayer meeting. Rev. D. D. McManis conducted the meeting.
6. Pa was at George H. M. G. getting advice about Hart.
7. Pa & Jimmie at Lunenburg today. Far got 1 ham at Willis, weighed 24 lb. Pa got  $3\frac{1}{2}$  lb steak .35  
I bought from a pedlar on Thursday a pair stockings 50  
Jimmie went to Martinsburg for order.
8. Robertson Bailiff seized Hart's cattle and brought them to our place & horned things. Horse began to rain.
9. Rev. M. Bennett of Summit preached today, raining a little all day.
10. Rained a good deal today. Hart's other horse, and light wagon, were brought here by P. Robertson got Harry shod.
