

26 Chored I got some <sup>Det</sup> Powder <sup>1872</sup> at Barrows <sup>Nov</sup> for Frank Pore he  
 didn't seem to be very well after his drive yesterday. W. very  
 steady rain all night and all day, raining yet about 11 o'clock  
 27 at home B's were here P.M. I went to Barrows this  
 evening Frank's legs are swelled some Jimmy Juice came  
 with me & gave him a Ball. W. rained nearly all day  
 looks like clearing up now. very wet & slippery  
 28 Chored this morning began to pull turnips about 9  
 o'clock J B came to help. W. fine clear. Frank some better  
 29 J B plowed in sod behind barn along bush awhile this  
 morning & I helped B's C kill 2 pigs. Then we all pulled  
 turnips. W. fine warm clear Frank some better  
 30 J B went to W's plowing Bee on Gannahill  
 Hornington's farm I & Dave pulled turnips after the  
 frost was off. W. fine warm clear  
 31 I started a little after 2 o'clock this morning to go to Toronto with  
 B's. As he had gone when I got there. Then I walked  
 to Agincourt Station on the Niagara, got well ser-  
 viced by a Lynce on the Markham road about 5 o'clock  
 A.M. went to Toronto for some German School Books  
 that came to me by Express from O'Keefe had rode  
 home with B's. W. very fine clear white frost last  
 Nov 1 Pulled turnips awhile A.M. Chored P.M. W. a little  
 rain A.M. Cloudy P.M. Cut a tree in Peaboss bush that  
 we thought had Coons in it but we found none  
 2 J B & Dave drew 4 loads turnips A.M. (they also drew 4  
 loads on Thursday A.M.) I Chored & went to Belford  
 we all pulled P.M. finished about 3.30 O'Clock P.M.  
 then J B & Dave went home & I went to Cedar Grove W  
 3 Sunday. I & Nancy went to Meeting at Cedar Grove <sup>fine clear</sup> <sup>sermons</sup>  
 by B's C Sermon on by R's B Barker  
 J D's were here when we came home & Abraham Dower  
 came P.M. W. fine, a few drops of rain P.M.  
 4 Drew in 10 loads turnips W. very fine clear  
 5 Drew in 17 loads turnips with 2 teams. Frank is better  
 again. W. East wind. began to rain at dusk from east  
 6 Drew in 10 loads turnips which finished them W. Cloudy  
 7 Drew two loads Potatoes out of field into little Orchard <sup>mild</sup>  
 Potted them. Chored P.M. W. Clear A.M. rained nearly all P.M.  
 Nancy & Adeline went to quilting at Mr. Neighbour's

Nov 8 Took <sup>6</sup> ewes to B's <sup>Nov</sup> & brought Galloway Bull  
 from B's so I intend to fatten him on sheres. A m  
 Dave took last potatoes 15 bags into cellar & drew 3 loads  
 wood P.M. W. rather cold. a slight squall P.M. Several that  
 Josiah Parsons Shanty, south of B's. was burned  
 this P.M. & his 3 children burned to death: shocking!  
 9 Dave plowed in root ground. I Chored & went  
 to Cherrywood A.M. Took some Chop to B's D's  
 Chopping mill in his Sawmill. I helped M Dyke  
 clear a lot of Peas brought home Chop this  
 evening. W. fine clear. Sharp frost last night  
 Sunday 10 all went to Meeting at Hebron sermons by Rev  
 A Barker Sermon on St John 10 C by B's C I & Nancy  
 went to B's C's awhile P.M. W. fine clear  
 11 I went to see J B to come & help me to draw barley  
 to Whitby. A.M. Helped M Dyke to put in some 4 in  
 tiles south of Graveyard P.M. W. Cloudy mild  
 12 I & J B took 2 loads & 8 lbs 19 lbs barley to Whitby  
 @ 65 cts. W. drizzly rain a few hours this morning  
 cleared up P.M. snow very heavy & slippery  
 M Dyke & Dave dug ~~at~~ ditch along  
 west side of lane & on townline part old  
 lime kiln to let water run east from lane  
 13 J B took 50 lbs 30 lbs barley to Whitby <sup>into creek</sup> @ 65 cts  
 I & R Gouly dug a grave at Hebron for Michael  
 Burkholder's child A.M. Went to funeral P.M.  
 Dave plowed in root ground. W. fine clear A.M. strong  
 East wind P.M. began to rain about 8 o'clock  
 14 I & Dave drew some lumber to new barn at M Dyke's  
 I & B's C have traded land I give him my Peaboss fifty  
 acres & the corner field that I bought off C B & \$500.00  
 for Lot No 4 containing 70 acres.  
 I took grist 10 lbs wheat to Cedar Grove Mill this evening  
 15 I & Dave moved some stones out of cellar <sup>cold wind</sup> at Dyke's barn & I went  
 to get in a few logs at Saw mill A.M. I cut some Cedar logs in  
 Flavin's Swamp to lay stable floors at Dyke's & helped  
 Dave finish putting dung on potatoes Jits P.M. W. hard  
 frost last night ground froze here  
 16 I went to Markham Dave & W. drew horse dung on heap in field  
 below garden I & W. brought load of Planks to Dyke's this evening W. cold clear
