

Wed 30 a Terrible thunder storm this morning
before we got out of bed to close turned right
over our head Paul was up pulling the horses
out & getting the cows in they are drawing manure
& finished coming the plow

Thurs 31. Marjorie went after dinner to Red Creek
after vinegar. I churned & put the butter on a crock
Paul helping them on the afternoon to draw manure
(got at Red 5:45 16 chest 1/2 lb. onion 1/2 lb. ginger 10" cool oil got
planned 10

Sept. 1905

Friday! Marjorie baked bread & croned part of
the clothes I finished them when she went to
the shop. I swept the front room yesterday & I changed
the col & swept & dusted the dining room & made a
batch of cookies in the forenoon. Paul went up straight
to his train Wells & see if that was any elderberries
the girls & their mother went to Drummondville & Helen
got plums & tomato & things for shriekers tomorrow
Sat 2 Marjorie had to go to Red. They finished
shredding just before 3 o'clock & started heat 20 min
after 3 our shredding lasted 3/4 of an hour. 99 was altogether
33 for us & 33 for Helen 733 for Frank brought ram on the
afternoon. I had to guard the cows & feed the calves
& wash dishes from our supper night before kept out
until noon. then I washed out a lot of things &
Marjorie brought home a basket of cucumbers some peas
& tomatoes & peppers & a root to cellar

Sun 3. if Pa had been living he would be 93 today
beautiful day wind west Arthur to dinner. Eva
Hannah & two of her friends in the other house

Hattie & Arthur over on the evening very cool night
Thurs & Labor Day. I churned & worked the butter
swept & dusted the school house instead of
Friday. there was school. Paul watched the cows
& drew a barrel of water & Marjorie the cows
while he drew it. Paul drew manure on the
afternoon. Arthur working on the fallow
Ten & looked like rain. Marjorie & Hattie went
to Drummondville got tomatoes 25 pr but each got a box
Hattie got one tooth on. I cleared up the woodhouse
so Paul could get the oats in from the barn
that was yesterday when Marjorie was watching
the cows he drew the water afterwards. Arthur
disking in forenoon rolling the afternoon I put
the butter on a crock & kept 1/2 the hours on side
of a week we had gone through a crock about 40 lbs
but a butter dish full & had to leave some of yesterday
the got a 25 lb brown 25 lb sugar 10 lb mixed spice rising cake
chest 14. Pomace & elastic 5. brought home the coal oil
& ginger they got the other day. today Paul went after
a basket of elderberries & we got them cleaned
Wed 6. I made an elderberry pie for supper just
before I started to sweep the school house. I carried
up 42 qt jars of tomatoes & 2.2 gal. jars elderberry
Marjorie went at night to Red to stay & help next day
