 We drove down town in morning with
 Jess in cutter I posted letter and Xmas
 Globe to Mrs Newton 12cts postage then we
 drove over to Blacks to see about raidition
 got bag brown at Armstrongs on aft showed
 Dr Armstrong Jess on road home. W.
 Kyle in in A M looking at our stock he offered
 us \$540 per cent for hoys. I took Bessie and
 a young sow over to Wilson in P M in sleigh.

Sunny and cloudy snowing some not very
 frosty. I took 5 hoys down to Kyle weighed
 970 lbs total 10cts and in P M took two loads
 turnips down to Rea all in sleigh with stock
 rack. Girls down in P M Willie in cutter
 got at Stabs gives 95 at Fells gives 20 Philips
 back calendar stamps etc 60 at Russells goods etc
 also paid 40 to express on water post for stove etc that Willie
 paid for in Snelgh. Mrs Henry Johns died this morning
