- 10 Saturday. Raining all day. I washed some of the ceiling of the hall upstairs, and put the flowers in the window. Jimmie went to Cornwall to see the lacrosse game between Shamrocks of Montreal and The Cornwalls. There has been a break of about 1 1/2 feet in the Cornwall canal at Millarville. It will take two weeks to fix it. Auntie & Jimmie were here last night. she gave me 95 cts. being the freight on her peaches
- 14. Reaching in the Hall, today
- 15. I washed today. P. Jim & Ken are letting the water of the potatoes at the village farm Rubber boots for Jim 2.75
- 16. Had a letter from Murdy. S. H. M. Kenzie died this afternoon.
- 17. Fine in the morning. we put up the porch at front door. Marion got 1 pair rubbers, 45c Pa. to felt boots 2.85 & cloth overshoes. 1.60. Jimmie got rubber overshoes 65c 2.25
- 19. The medals were presented at the school today. Birdie did not come until evening. This has been our fast day. Rev. M. Lutch preached
- 20 Saturday Mr Given preached.
- 21 Cold day. a goodly number out today. both morning and evening. Mathewson addressed the evening service. The collection today is for Home Mission. we put in 1.75
- 22. Made a large washing Jimmie went for lumber to Lunenburg
- 23 Niagara concert in the Hall Bird went
- 24 Prayer Meeting was conducted by Rev Donald Mrs Ann Edwards did today. on 25 out on 24th
- 25 A temperance meeting Casey of Napier was there I gave Jimmie \$1.00 Willie Louden worked this afternoon at clapboarding Collets house
- 26 Gordon & Courie worked this afternoon. Very fine day. Pa got money yesterday paid his debts 100 or 70
- 27 Running all day. got 1 yd cotton 10 1/2 wadded 5 15

- 31 Sent a letter to Murdy with \$ 23.00 2 for Celtic Soc. 23
