- Tue Oct 13. Fine bright day. Annie here at night. I went to Toronto.
- Wed Oct 14. Fine bright a perfect day. Mrs D. picking apples gave me ^{some}.
- Thur Oct 15. ^{As time covered.} Fine bright day. I went to Miss Wilsons with vase for Shower and fifty cents for present. Sleeping in west bed room.
- Fri Oct 16. Fine day untill evening started to rain and rained steadily all night. Annie came for tea. I was at Dentists ⁸ had front tooth filled where enamel cracked off inlay.
- Sat Oct 17. Strong. N.W. wind and clearing. fire every afternoon put in Double door. I went to Alice Sefton's they came for me.
- Sun Oct 18. Dull and cold. at Deer Park. Thanks giving Service. at John Cooks for tea.
