- 20
- 21 finished wheat at the New Farm
- 22 went to Caintown & heard the Rev. W. W. Donach
- 23 cut the oats below the house fine
- 24 Ellen & Gypspa went to Brockville & sold 20 lb of butter @ 1/2 per lb 1 chees. 15 lb @ 5 per lb
- 25 drew in 15 loads of wheat at the New Farm & began to cut the oats on the Prye ground
- 26 finished cutting the oats & drew in the wheat
- 27 drew in the oats on the Prye ground & the wheat below the house & the Parly
- 28 drew in the oats below the house in the morning raised after Breakfast David dragged at crishes
- 29 went to Brockville with W. M. Hazelwood & heard the Rev. W. M. preach & got tokens for the sacrament
- 30 David drew dung to the crishes place ^{some showers}
- 31 intended to go to Brockville to the sacrament but rained so that we could not go we went to Caintown & heard the Rev. W. W. Mummy
- 32 drew dung to the crishes place ^{little rain}
- 33 began to flow at crishes place & I thrashed seed very dull & cloudy weather
