Fine Windy John H & Jack D Spunk here
came to see the Building Leander and Randolph
here hunting Lucius for Potatoes 20 cents
30th Fine W Wind cool Fernandez went to
Lancaster for Rafters for the Kitchen part
Stanley Ploughing Gordon at the Building
Fernandez got 120 feet of Lumber and Rafters
Junk or Tin for the Roof of the Kitchen
Gordon and Fernandez crossed tonight for
Mails Sent off 2 Letters with them
to put in the Post Office one to D. M. M.
and one to Arthur Craig of the Glenarrigan postage
and Register 9 cents containing 1 Dollar got a
Receipt for Envelopes Nails Butter tub 25
31st Holy-Eve. the Night of the JAMES
Boarding East End of the Kitchen Shooting
with the Double-Barrel Gun to Day Bought
Powder Shot and Caps Last night at Haggarty
a Lot of Shooting to Day cracking nuts
to night Keeping the Hall-~~er~~ East Wind
Raining hard to night 1st of NOVEMBER
All Saints Day The Harvest Month Death
East Wind Raining hard some shooting
fired 5 shots at a Duck did not
get him Gordon Making Hammer handles
George hard to night
Annie's Baby Born on 6th November
1899

JAMES CAMERON Island November 2nd 1899
Fine cool W Wind Sissy and Stanley went to Mill
with Wheat took the oil Jar had 2 Spunks
Boat Lucias here Bought 2 Tubs of Butter
They went off to Day Left their Fish-Box
3rd Fine Working at the Building Stanley Ploughing
George Creaner her for Livinia East Wind took up
Annie's Bed Sent some Books to Min got a
Pipe from George Heard a Rumble noise
like an Earthquake about 8 or 2 past 8 o'clock
one of the White Ducks killed and 1 of the Black
Ducks caught in the trap Fixing a Fence
around the upper field Stack Rained
hard to night 4th Wind West Rained hard
and Blew head to Day Working at the Building
Stanley finished ploughing the north side East
Leander came with the Mail or Letter
from John Cameron Kansas and the Scottish
American and a Map of the War Chart of
South Africa Raining and Windy to night
5th Gunpowder Plot Guy Fawkes Day
Fine Day 6th Fine W Wind Stanley Ploughing
Leander and Randolph here had the Mail
Gordon Working at the Cornshes 2 Boats
Collided at Stanley Island the Captain's Son
Killed Genie here
on the 5th took a fainting turn at night 6th
