## Early Diagnosis of Cancer—No. 3.

Retraction of the nipple, or dimpling of the skin, is a positive sign of cancer, even without tumor, and operation should be performed at once.

Ulceration of a nipple in a non-lactating breast, without a history of injury or lues, should be treated as cancer.

In cancer of the female breast before there is involvement of the axillary glands, the percentage of cures is 70 to 80 per cent.; and in cases where the glands are involved 20 to 30 per cent., a record that is not at all discouraging.—McGregor; *Northwestern Lancet*.
