wall for 1000 lbs flour  
sent two flannel shirts 1 pair  
socks. and 5 dollars to Murdy 5.00
- 18 Quite stormy for a while today  
snow flakes as large as a cent
- 19 Sabbath Mr Mc Callaway announced  
from the pulpit his intentions of leaving  
this congregation. he has an offer from  
the French Evangelization Committee  
to go to Britain as their agent which  
he thinks he will accept.  
Temperance meeting. are going to have  
a strong Sect Act. Thanks giving  
Pa and Jimie are working with Pelam  
cutting out manure pile day
