- 18 Quite stormy for a while today
snow flakes as large as a cent
- 19 Sabbath Mr Mc Gillivray announced
from the pulpit his intentions of leaving
this congregation. He has an offer from
the French Evangelization Committee
to go to Britain as their agent which
he thinks he will accept
Temperance meeting. Are going to have
a strong Scot Act Thanksgiving
- Pa and Jim are working with Pelam
