16	<p>Thursday Misty morning warm day sunny. Willie at Fords threshing A.M. Cloudy P.M. I plowed sod No 6 all day E.M. Girls went up to Maggie Barnett in P.M. Lucy in buggy they got at Armstrongs on aft goods \$2.30</p>		
17	<p>Friday Fine sunny day. Willie at Lindale threshing 2-day. I plowed sod No 6 A.M. brought two loads wood for threshing. W & J Sister brought calves up from home gave the 10 cts & basket apples.
