September 13 continued Monday toward
 got at Armstrongs on of flour & sugar \$4.15
 at Boys rope bran \$1.25 sheets \$1.55 on of at Mead
 on of longhandled shovel 75¢ paid J. Lindley \$1.00
 Fall show membership - took low wagon wheel
 to Hodge to get tire set. He went back to Estes
 again for carpet and picture from Estes. We bought
 up load wood from bush before dinner.
 I plowed out pea land No 7 stump field also
 plowed few rounds in sod No 6 & M. Willie plowed
 No 7 4 hours P.M. and I cemented some more
 of cellar rest of coal bin also at kitchen cellar window.

14 Tuesday

Fine sunny day very warm Willie plowed
 all day No 7 pea land 4 hours. I cemented some more
 cellar floor. Father in afternoon gave him 2 letter to post
 Y.M.C.A. \$1.00 Simmers for oats \$1.15. Grass seed 5¢
 Willie whaled up to Irvine at night.

Warm, mostly cloudy rained heavy about 2 P.M. I went to Smith's
 Exhibition today expenses 95cts. Willie finished plowing pea land No 7
 and harrowed it. Girls up at Indale at night. I went up when I got home.

16 Thursday

Misty morning warmer day sunny. Willie at forks
 threshing A.M. Dowdy P.M. I plowed sod no 6 all day team.
 Girls went up to Maggie Barnett in PM Lucy in buggy
 they got at Armstrongs on of goods \$2.50

17 Friday

Fine sunny day. Willie at Indale threshing 2 day. I plowed sod No 6 AM brought
 two loads wood for threshing. W. & I later brought calves up from home gave them 1/2 lb broken apples. Mrs. Queenie and
 Lizzie up for tea. Mrs. Queenie for milk 5cts. I cut some corn in evening last bed like frost.
