 W Wind Frosty cut the Butternut sawed the
 Butternut & went to upper point some frosty
 John H getting squares 17" high W Wind
 sawed the Butternut 12 and 9 feet & new
 some wood from the Pitt Point 18th
 Change this morning snowed: Hamed & Wind
 soft Leander and cutting brush putting it
 on the Break fence in the swamp 18th
 Wind breaking the ice near shore Broke
 on a 4 ton stack of Marsh hay 19th Sunday
 Windy 20th Last Day of Fall a Fine Day went
 to Slemmer's next burn a good deal of anchor
 ice in the channel Bought of Nicholas
 100 of Flour 2 1/2 cts Electrick oil 25 1/2 lbs Cracker
 7 1/2 pipes 2 1/2 a Bushel of Oals 1 Hammiton
 in Cornwall left our Boat opposite Kenuk
 as the Channel is Froze of Slemmer's town
 Wind Raised high 13 reaching the ice to the
 shore 21st First Day of Winter Nomination
 for Mr M^r Lemman Windy cutting Brush
 and putting it on the Swamp Fence
 some snowing 22nd Fine Calm cutting a tree
 on the hill Antwine Bosell and Lemans
 son here Antwine fixed the clock gave
 them a stick for eel poles Lade me
 6 Ells 2 Boats Fishing Ells at christie
 told me young Hlenery's wife departed
 2 weeks ago Rowena not well to Day
 something wrong with the Horse
 23rd Fine Day put hay out of the stack on
 put some in the stable left
 4 new shutters for the outside of
 the windows the Horse not well
 giving him Medicine but he is gang to die
 24th Morning & Wind Meeting at 1/2 ton on
 Slemmer's town Dan Mc Lemman came well to Day

 Frost was 6th 7th fine & Wind Frosty
 Horse Dead Drove him out of the stable
 got a Muskrat alive put the skin on
 Cousin's head as they say its good for
 taking the pain out of the head and
 of supping walking the Eagle flying about
 hot much snow on the ground if it was not
 calm the ice would take to night making yards
 some 2 1/2 cts Ice Took 1/2 Wind Frosty cold 27th
 West Wind Cold some freezing 28th Election
 for Mr Lemman & Kayville West crossing
 on the ice Fine cold West Wind a good
 many air holes a good many cracks in our
 load went to Hammiton 7 boats to night
 they say the ice got ~~ice~~ a small margin
 of 30 but its not known right yet
 may be contested yet 29th Our Angus
 Birth Day went to Hammiton Harp
 girls there from Lachin Dan Mc Greggor
 here got a Razor and my own Razor
 from Gordon got some apples from
 went to Cornwall Frosty to night
 30th Cold & Wind Smoky with the fog out
 of the air holes Gusty Hlenes here cropping
 to Antwine its too cold he turned back
 James got a Mink skinned
 him hurted my back on a pain come
 on it as Reas lefting a stick 31st
 ast Day of this Year & Wind cold
 snowing drifting a Man crossed
 from the head to the head
 of our Island on scales
