

Broton April 1903

Mar 31st clear and pleasant. I dug some in the garden and took up apples I had pited in barrels there was about $\frac{2}{3}$ of them rotten

Wed Apr 1st cloudy and cool. I was digging the garden. Mr Bingham moved back on the Smith farm

Thu Apr 2nd cloudy and thunder showers I got some Strawberry plants from Mrs Browder and set out and dug a little in the garden.

Fri Apr 3rd rain fore noon snow after noon about three inches on the ground while writing Sarah was cleaning house this after noon. Roy Paul was here awhile this evening

Sat Apr 4th cloudy and cool. Thomas Bilton and Bilton Snary was here

Sun Apr 5th clear fore part of the day latter part cloudy

Mon Apr 6th cloudy most of the day and mild I was digging the garden. John was here he got some onions and sugar

Tue Apr 7th clear with high cool wind from the South West. I was digging the garden part of the day. Bilton called to day

Wed Apr 8th fore noon cloudy after noon clear and pleasant. I went down to the old home this after noon for berry bush plants and set the out

Thu Apr 9th clear high wind from South West I was doing some digging in the garden

Fri Apr 10th cloudy. I burnt the brush I cut of the apple trees. Sarah here in the fore noon went over to see Pearl who is sick. Bilton called to day.

Sat Apr 11th cold a cold drizzling rainy day Sarah was here this after noon baking

Sun Apr 12th cloudy and cool wind from the North East this being Easter the prospect is for cold wet Spring
