Very frosty day cloudy and snowing  
 15 at times. We cleaned 11 bags pig chaff 4 M.  
 P M Willie took it down to Wilkins and got  
 it 41 cts and 300 lbs black dust 1.80. glass &  
 putty 87<sup>cts</sup> for parlour window and hammer  
 40 cts got at Nichols new bricks for happy thought  
 stove 1.76 got tile at Malcolms 80 cts for  
 well in cellar 1 ft diameter also paid 30 cts for  
 493 damaged 8 in tiles got last week. He got  
 bricks for stove at Kears 90 cts but will  
 have to exchange them. Mary went down with  
 him stayed down went to Dr. <sup>got medicine 75<sup>cts</sup> paid</sup> I put iron  
 gate in sheep house and put pea straw in  
 above manger north house. Mrs Bonbrun and  
 teacher Miss Blackstone called P M. Willie  
 drove me down at night I went to meeting  
 of managers he exchanged points for stove at  
 Nichols and drove home. I walked up.
