the rain slacked up in see about baking  
for the festival.

Sun 28 very cool the air full of perfume of  
the apple & lilac Hattie brought over a nice  
boquet for us. Platt had a fall on the night  
Mon 29 took a cloudy Paul took Marjorie to  
James Wells came home & guarded the cows  
I put on the pop corn & mangel seed  
now I wish it was out for its growing  
rain from the north east. Hill & Arthur  
took a load of oats to Aden Well & got  
the bananas for the Social tomorrow  
Tue 30 I made cookies Paul guarded the  
cows on the morning after dinner gally  
around back & forth. In the church &  
fancy at a pig Arthur & Allen Humber  
gathered the cakes not a bad day the  
night is dark & chilly quite a  
big burn out made over 30 dollars  
Wed 31. I washed the dishes for the  
corner cupboard & put the pants

oil cloth down. Set the hen yesterday  
got the eggs from Maggie & set the  
black hen in the barn on our own  
eggs. Paul went over to the church at  
noon as he got his breakfast. In help of  
sheep wanted him brought home quite a  
lot of cake that filled. Paul up for the  
I swept the school house at night.

Thur 1<sup>st</sup> June 1905  
I done a churning the first in a good many  
weeks had a big time getting the churn & butter base  
Friday 2 not a bad day. I planted beans  
& some potatoes out on the east side of the house  
after dinner Paul planted some sweet corn &  
I swept & dusted the school house. yesterday  
fixed my flowering peas I got two hills of  
cucumbers out. Lily & Hattie went to Chippewa  
took 1 1/2 eggs 16 got 2 lb coal oil 1<sup>st</sup> nails 1 loaf  
bread & 4 nutmegs Arthur & his mother over at night  
Sat 3 I churned the first thing just as I  
got through a big swarm of bees came out of  
the pot out here I got every thing ready to  
keep them Paul came from guarding the  
cows & he knocked them down they went on  
the line but did not stay went away in  
spite of all the music. I worked the butter  
I went to Chippewa with Paul 4 1/2 @ 12 1/2  
and came to 66 got tea nails, spades & sugar bread
