CARCINOMA OF THE UTERUS. Irregular metrorrhagia, accompanied by an offensive watery vaginal discharge, occurring in middle-aged women whose menstruation has ceased or become atypical, or bleeding which occurs on coitus or exertion, are indications of malignancy.

CARCINOMA OF THE BREAST. Any growth in the breast of a woman of middle age is best considered and treated as malignant.—Levin; Archives of Diagnosis.
