hair looking for 7 months since Betty
first money she got of her wages gave Spring some change
on Bushaws 5th sent him a Bag 2nd from Cottons home
Hanging lead took the top out of the pot fixed the Lead
Barrel 2nd Sunday Raining got 2nd 7th room
Calvin's man for Bread and sleeping in the Barn
I arranged to mow Marsh day morning. Bath
dove a house of the Betty Betty Pickings the rabbits
ten cents and the fiddler craped 30th morning
oat straw hay put up in some oats loaf of
pound to a man of 7th 1/2 of 1/2 of 1/2 of 3 load day
hay in the east side shot a duck. Partridge the 20th
got at the fall finished cutting the black oats 3rd
Exit the last of the barley but in the last of the black
Betty cooked home Jan's Birth Day 4th Sunday
Barn. Last wind Rain got 2 squirrels in the trap 5th cut some
oats and Marsh Hay 6th went to Salina River 5th 1/2
at Salina many to charge 1 cent for the cloth found morning
The Council of a great party in Bought of Molasses
I put some money for 2nd pounds 2nd 1/2
for on the 5th paid for castor oil for
the women to the last took

Betty Bone & class here from Soms very early
about 10 o'clock took breakfast ^{here} An old man
Fishing name Lewis Dushaw taking grapes & cranberries
Rut in a few coals Key on the stack put in a bag
of Buckwheat 2nd 1/2 in about 9 Bushels of
Potatoes in the cellar 25 Sunday all alone
2nd Cutting the Buckwheat in the upper field
Nory Cameron & John Noy here looking for sand
gave me a Hooker wanting a 100 Bushels
of sand 2nd Finished the Buckwheat went to
7th class went and put up 50 Bushels and
home gave him a dog that High Wind 28th Drawing
of Herring put in 2nd the Heap of sand taking home
loads of Barley Blacken Cucumbers
Bad 8th cut the rest of the white oats of the
Barley 2 Bushels a great deal of Hog trap in it for Providence
10th finished the oats but taking them 2 small loads
the east side of Gordon Lost I was sure he was
drowned as we searched so much for him found
him on the trap at the corner of the Potatoes asleep
Cathy here shot 2 very fat Ducks of what I call
the coat kind since they have no tail 11 Sunday
A Quiet Day not any one moving about on the water
A Steamer on the Back Channel & Wharving all the Morning
12th Angus & James M. Bain here looking at the cows
Drawing the old house over to the Barn 13th Cathy here
Herring sticks around the stack 14th Betty came Angus came
the cows Jan M. Douglas and Charles Rose here
Dutcher Johny Noll finished about March before
I went to the Bay - 15th Angus here
