

- 21. Mrs Sandy Bran, all were telling me I should be in bed, so after supper I am going ^{and} will not get up until I am better. Got ^{on Sunday} ~~Edith~~ out.
- 24. I got up at 3 P.M. I am not feeling very strong. On the 22 Murdy went to Cornwall to a suit. Jimmie is before the assays. he got home today. Jimmie went up yesterday only got there last night. Far came with him. We got 1 pan bread on 22, 24th 2 qts milk on 22. On the 21st Murdy got 2 lbs butter at Willis. Jimmie got 4 lbs at factory. Mrs Santum took our flannel washing, will do it at her house. Yesterday & today are lovely days. Snow melting.
- 25. Far left for Cornwall. Jimmie drove him to Gore Station. 70 1/2 gall milk 20. Bread 24. Mrs Santum brought home the washing 25th. I sent one dollar to May for Mrs A Co's parcel on the 23rd. The gift will be presented tonight.
- 24. Rained all last night and some this morning. our creek is over the two bridges. 70 pan bread 24. John P. McLennan is down with milk. he says the roads are very bad. Mrs Santum brought clothes.
- 27. I was up all afternoon. Very fine day, cold not thawing. A pretty large congregation.
- 28. Mrs Campbell was in yesterday. she said that the M. & M. D. present to Mrs A. Co was a ten dollar gold piece. And the ladies had a pleasant night getting home at midnight. 70 1/2 gall milk J. P. down with milk. I was up all day 1 lb tea on eggs.
- 29. 70 15 lbs on eggs. 70th on eggs 1 pan bread 25. Got the wood cut by Salween Woods. 3.60. 2 men all day 1.75 day 2.50 for men.
- 30. Before Santum splitting wood. all day 1.00.
- 31. The black snapper had a calf this morning. The boys killed & skinned it. 70 1/2 gall milk. put in stove wood in shed.

- 1. Friday, warm day a drizzle of rain. 70 1/2 pan bread 25.
- 2. Throwing. Had a note from the Branch. They have something there. Mundy by 4 lbs butter. Pilled with M. Common. he paid a balance of 1.55.
- 3. Very fine day not many in church. Mary Gore was in for a short time. Jim Ferguson (Push) died last night. will be buried here tomorrow.
- 4. Fine bright day. Jimmie went to funeral in buggy. took tea - Sandy Pedgrew's wife paid 1.50 for rent. 70 pan bread 24. Sold the chicks.
- 14. Went to the Branch on Tuesday 6th. Got back yesterday 13. Had a letter from Marum. wrote her today. Bridie's babe is a girl. I do not know what was done here while I was away.
- 15. Jimmie sent some milk to the factory. got 4 lbs butter. Archie McArthur square had a sale of cattle and implements. I have sore eyes.
- 16. 70 1/2 pan bread 24 Murdy. I can scarcely see.
- 17. One eye very bad. Jimmie topped the maples around the house & on Friday they ran well yesterday and today. we are boiling on the Kitchan stove. Burning more wood than would buy the syrup. Sold 8 doz @ 5 eggs. 96. Got some stick 10.
- 18. April 9th 10 sugar 25. Jim out manure & loads.
- 19. Dull began to rain about 10.2 P.M. Saturday papers said that on Friday there was a snow storm in Ontario that stopped traffic on the Rail Roads even Toronto had over four inches of snow.
- 20. About 4 inches of snow at 5 A.M. Nov 9. 40 about 7 inches. and still snowing. Jimmie went to factory with cutter. Nothing but whistles in the 4th. Had a letter from Uncle Sandy. The Gazette says a large fire in Toronto last night.
