4 continued Saturday Forward

Till 10 o'clock A.M. scuffling turnips then went home on afternoon. Willie took Kate down to P.A. in morning and brought up the three calves that were at home. He made two rope drills before rain. In P.M. we tidied up barn etc. Willie paid W Rea in full 4.00

I went down town at night got at Russells 2 shirts 2 collars \$2.09 (due bill) at Chapman 4.00

6 shirts for mowers 35cts 1 set of pants & coat of 45cts 45 35-

5 Sunday

Fine day warm sunny. Our Sacrament Sunday Mr. Brown preached in A.M. from and in evening Mr. Brown of St. Andrews to united congregation from Psalms 119 59 Church roll 25

I went over to Belzede with D.B. Scott to Brother meeting 25-

6 Monday

Fine sunny day warm looked like rain P.M. James Bergin up all day painting. W Rea hoeing all day. We hoed most of potatoes, scuffled manure to-day. Girls went down in P.M. Lucy in buggy to see Jessie and Marin Ross they were at home stayed off for night train on way to Hanover Uncle Jim went up with them. they got meat Wills 30cts yeast cake 10 tea 20 eggs Mrs. Mutch 64 64 30 30

7 Tuesday

Cloudy day rained A.M. some heavy at noon at intervals P.M. Bergin party to day. W Rea hoeing A.M. we drilled for rope around 4 drills A.M. sundy jobs P.M. Willie down town got at Bruntings groceries 185 sold eggs 80 chry bal 95. stamps 2cts. Gus had land Kate to scuffle his potatoes 80 82
