7. Began to rain about 10 A.M. and soon one very heavy shower, then another heavy shower in afternoon

9. Professor Holmes opened his singing class this evening
10. No prayer meeting this evening, singing
11. Prayer meeting this evening. Aunt gave Marion 1 hat
12. Brought at Willies 2 yds cotton 1 spool B. Thread 1 doz front buttons,
13. Aunt gave Bird a white hat and flower got at Mrs Gushys 3/4 yd. tinsel for hat 56 1 yd lace 25
14. Rained this morning. Rev Mr Calder of Lancaster preached, no prayer meeting. Mr O'Flaherty in Mon
15. Rained all day. Fur went to Gore
16. Nothing done, but what was done in the house
17. Jimmie has a gum boil. Murdy worked 1/2 day for
