Tue April 30<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. I was cleaning out water furrows for John. he was harrowing for me he and Walter was getting the pea ground for drilling

Wed April May 1<sup>st</sup> Clear fore part of the day. latter part cloudy and cool. Walter and Dickie was drilling in peas. I was breaking clods

Thu May 2<sup>nd</sup> cloudy misting rain in the after noon. Walter was rolling peas in the fore noon. after noon furrowing the ground. I was cleaning out furrows

Fri May 3<sup>rd</sup> clear wind from the North and cold a sharp frost last night. we finished sowing to day for this season. I was cleaning out water furrows in the pea ground.

Sat May 4<sup>th</sup> clear and warm. I was trimming apple trees. Walter was plowing.

Sun May 5<sup>th</sup> clear and warm. Quarterley Meeting to day at Florence to day I was not there. Jory and Sarah was home to day.

Mon May 6<sup>th</sup> clear and warm. I was trimming apple trees in the fore noon. after noon attended the Quarterley board at Florence. Walter was plowing the little piece North East of the barn.

Tue May 7<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. Walter was harrowing the corn ground. I was trimming apple trees in the fore noon. after noon planting onions and sowing onion seeds.
