- 3 Was digging after 8. A.M. Jimmie went to Cornwall <sup>sent him \$2.00</sup>
- 4 settled weather Paid milk 35. Granite cement 15<sup>cts</sup> 0-30
- 5 Very fine day. I was in church off 25
- 6 Another fine day. To butter 46<sup>cts</sup> Mrs Willie Barrell 66 and I went to call on Robertsons. They were not at home, we saw the grounds and garden and the outside of the new addition to the north end
- 7 Another fine day. I am cleaning beans To 2 loaves 12 To 1 lb tea 35 45
- 8 A.M. in forestry. My off 50. gave 15 toward freight on base to Toronto To 1 gal wool oil 20 65
- 9 Dull day. Mrs Fairbanks came with a message from Mrs Robertson for me to go and spend the evening. Jimmie drove me down about 4 P.M. They were getting ready to go for a drive. I went with them, we drove up the south side of the river, crossed M Gillivray's bridge back on the north side. I remained until 9 P.M. the ladies came home with me I enjoyed the outing very much. Muddy went to Cornwall today. Did not come home in evening Tuppurs baby is sick They took it to Montreal to a Dr. To 2 loaves 12. I owe Jimmie 42<sup>cts</sup> 12
- 10 Settled with Jimmie
- 11 To 2 lbs butter 70<sup>cts</sup> biscuit 10. Sat. biscuit 10 90  
2 loaves 12. Saturday before communion, Rev Sutherland preached. text. 12. Mark 10 10

- 12 Sunday very fine. Good congregation, my off 1.00 1-00  
We heard that Tuppurs baby died last night in Montreal.
- 13 Fine bright day. Tuppurs baby was buried this afternoon. A large funeral, all the pupils of High and public schools. were there The wind was cold. I called to see Mrs M Corum who is not well
- 14 Fine bright day. Sun 1/2 day 30. Jimmie left with Mr. Govin for Dunvegan to a C.C. and H.S. convention. To 2 loaves 12. I pulled the carrots 12 30
- 15 Bright day. Miss McGillivray has a sale (Auction), today farm implements cattle &c Jimmie and his reverence got home about 6 P.M.
- 16 Mild day. Jimmie bought a skiff at the sale yesterday. 18 1/2 feet long. 4 oars full for sail There is very little water in the river. The dam is down and all the water run out. To butter 35 35
- 17 Mild day, no sun. Jimmie got John Fraser, and went to McGillivray and got about 300 books. That Miss McGillivray was donating to the Public Library. To 2 loaves 12. Mrs Christie came about 2.30. for the school children remained until 5 P.M. 12
- 18 Fine day. Killed two cockrils. baked molasses cakes and two pies: currant, 6 puffs. To 3 loaves 18<sup>cts</sup> 18  
2 lbs butter 60. 1 bag hen feed (wheat) 1.75 2-35  
Paid 35 for milk 35
- 19 Fur came at 9.30. I did not go to church. sent off 25. and 1<sup>00</sup> for General Hospital Cornwall 1. 25  
Fur brought me \$18<sup>00</sup> sent to Mrs Cottanock \$2<sup>00</sup> 2. 00  
for my mite box off. to go to Missions. Evening rain
- 20 Rained all night. Cleared up a little in evening
- 21 Rain all day. Thunder & lightning at night
- 21 Cold wind. I washed a few things. Fur left 5 old towels To 2 loaves 12 12
