 We worked potatoes and planted three rows of the St George potatoes as follows: starting at mangles 1st row "S.W. Raleigh" then from top down^{No 2} to opposite bruntings house then "Pride of Britain" from there down and up row No 3 till about opposite side road then short stretch of Early Wonder and rest of row to top New Britain then from top of No 4 rest of M. Britain's short stretch, then commence Stratton potatoes except that we have short stretch from N.P. down of "Mammoth Bunch" 3 lbs Experimental from Ottawa potatoes. Then Irish Cobbler to bottom of No 4 No 5 is all "Gold corn" also short stretch from top of No 6 down the rest is our own seed. Willie drove down and brought up 4 other and Walter they stayed up all day & left Willie drove another down at noon with Jess in buggy to feed hrs. Lewis drove them down at night. Mr Lunn got \$185 worth of hay and 15 ds straw from us in AM. I went to concert at night admittance 25- paid Rogers for sawing logs \$2.70.

Strong east wind to-day cloudy & sunny cool. We spent 4 loads manure on No 1 then took down the three cattle sold on 23rd to Stratton they weighed 2930 lbs @ 45¢ 131.75 received balance 126.75 weighing 15 ds. Willie got potatoes from Geo Downham Stratton express 84 got brushed corn at Drumhony on of cool tar at Wicks 65 ds. Jim Ternal up in P.M. we planted potatoes as stated in yesterday's statement. Paid Jim 25- he disked some in black muck on No 2 I fixed fence on Gordon St in P.M. 7 our young cattle on grass in P.M. for white first time we keep them all in stable yet. Raining in P.M. and evening
