Cloudy day partly sunny in A.M. We made new door for horse stable of hardwood flooring and put it on with large hinges. Willie drove down with Lucy in buggy in A.M. got at Memmie's hinges 40 bit 15 nails 50. got harness mended at M: Demmets 20 cts Girls down in P.M. got Lucy shod at Tomplus 20 cts on aft paid Russell's aft for mulling & oil cloth \$7.65 Received from auntie for butter 34 Besides the above got at Memmie's staples 5 all on aft
