I made some of a temporary lane fence down near orchard to let cattle to pasture using the welded wire fence Willie harrowed and cultivated in No 1. P M we spread a load manure to from pig pen on No 1 opposite pig pen. Mary and Bella drove down home P M Punch in buggy Bella came up in evening Mary stayed down Mary got meat 40cts bread 1/2 pounds 46

Cool sunny and cloudy. I worked at lane fence A M Willie harrowed corn & also green crop land. P M Willie disked green crop land from N.E. fence No 1 over to potatoes & horses we sowed 20 more drills corn from fence then 3 more rows other side of corn already in. The 17 row from N E fence and at bottom is horse corn. Mary came up from

54 house P M she got for ~~the~~ at 70 in meat 30cts Cod liver oil for 7 25ct or 10cts dippings 8cts. Mrs Sam M. Kee over P M she paid 50cts Cam promised for Andrew Behaviors present and which I paid for him Mary gave her 10cts balance on eggs. Bella went down at night

Cloudy day rained most P M. We sowed fertilizer drilled up 12 drills and sowed them with oranges carrots and turnips A.M. P M we worked at movable row house etc. Willie drove Mary down and brought her back again he got at Thompsons 4gals gasoline \$1.32 exceedingly wet weather our corn is not up yet the south field looks
