The 17 now from N.E. fence and at bottom is horse corn. Mary came up from

home P M she got for ~~the~~ at 70 m meat 30cts God liver oil for 7 25 cents 10cts dippings 8cts Mrs Sam McKee over P M she paid 50cts Corn promised for Andrew Schaefer present and which I paid for him Mary gave her 10cts balance on eggs. Bella went down night
