Broke and having to walk so
far wrote a letter to Day to Dan
5th Fine Day Fernandez came
Gordon crossed gave him a
letter to put in the P.O. to Dan
put down at the Land
on the south side
Break on another Stack

James Cameron Island 6th of January 1898
Enhaw Fine Wind soft a few
Drops of Rain Howls Barking
Crossing the ice Down at Juppess
Island Stanley and Fernandez Down
at the Hut the Fernandez crossed to
the Post office Bought a Lamp Chimney
7th Fine Day Drew some Wood to
the camp Heard the Earthquake
about 2 Past one there is to
Be an Eclipse on the
moon to night 35 after
Full moon comes in to Day
8th ANNIE'S Birth Day 1866
Fine Rained some Thawing water
on the ice Stanley crossed for the
Mail got a Paper from Kansas
it Looks more like an Eclipse to
night Windy West 9th Fine
2 of Lewis folks here have them
a Lot of Papers and the Headstall
10th Fine Day Fernandez went
to Fort Covington Took 3 Foxes
and a Milk Council in Dundee
