Willie cultivated 7 1/2 field to-day 4 horses
I did sundry jobs put bank up
along fence between us & Fords No 2. 11
fixed pig pen for Sow Fanny who
had 14 pigs in bush last night bring
to-day we put her in her pen. brought over
bbl apples from Market N. My. 1 gal Milk Market 4.

Wednesday

Fine day sunny and cloudy frost last
night higher temperature. Willie plowed
all day Perrin plow No 7 W. I worked
at ditch No 2. I drove to creamery
with 3 milk samples to get tested
no one there came back then went
down again for 7 red Armstrong
for sick sow after that we went
4 times length of drain No 2 with our
drain digger 4 horses and shovels some out.
Mrs Dunn moved to her house to-day

Thursday

Fine sunny day. We plowed No 7
Perrin plow and worked at drain No 2
very springy and hard to lay. we put
pieces of old sacks around the joints.
7 red Armstrong in in morning to see sick
sow Willie went down for him last night
between 11 and 1 o'clock. Willie down for
papers etc on wheel at night.
